Environmental Management



The basis of CCE's environmental policy is simple: to reduce, reuse or recycle wherever possible.

An increasing number of organisations are inclined – if not obliged – to include an environmental policy in their vendor selection criteria.

At CCE we take our environmental responsibility very seriously, prioritising it in all of our business activities from everyday operations to the design of services and use of technology.

Our corporate environmental policy has been in place since 2005, supported by a stringent environmental management system – a continual cycle of planning, implementing, reviewing and improving our processes and actions to meet our environmental obligations and objectives.

The basis of CCE's environmental policy is simple: to reduce, reuse or recycle wherever possible. Our operations have a very low environmental impact in terms of carbon emissions, pollution and unnecessary use of raw materials. We extend the lifecycle of IT equipment for as long as economically possible, unless doing so would cause greater environmental impact. Engineers are issued with hybrid technology cars when existing vehicles are due for replacement.

Environmental certification

Our activities, products and services conform to ISO 14001:2004, a series of international standards which provides a framework for the development of an environmental management system and supporting audit programme. Certification for the standard required the following processes:

- Assessment visit to our site to review our existing procedures
- Comparison of existing procedures against the requirements of ISO 14001, to identify areas of non-compliance
- Assistance in formulating new and/or revised procedures to rectify any areas identified
- Preparation of an Environmental Management Report
- Preparation and supply of an Environmental Management Manual
- Issue of ISO 14001 Certificate within three months of a successful assessment taking place, which is valid for a ten year period
- Annual external audits carried out to maintain certification

Waste transport / WEEE

We also hold a Waste Carrier's Licence from the Environment Agency under the control of Pollution (Amendment) Act 1989. This entitles us to legally transport controlled waste from the point of production to the point of treatment. We offer an inexpensive and environmentally friendly solution to modern day e-waste disposal issues under the WEEE Directive, (The Waste Electrical & Electronic Equipment Directive) and can provide full disposal certification. All the equipment we receive undergoes a full refurbishment and data cleansing process, with that can be brought back to full health re-used. At the end of its service life, equipment is disposed of by certified specialist contractors in line with industry best practice.
